## **CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED BY SECRETARY (INCLUDING MEETINGS)**

- Clare Wilde of Contact the Elderly Still is still looking for volunteers to host party for the elderly residents. This will be 2 hours on a Sunday. The first one being Sun 27<sup>th</sup> November and as yet has no place to host.
- Corkerhill Swing Park is still under review. Some repairs will be made and items chained up due to health and safety implications.
- MP Chris Stephens and Cllr Watson email – Airth Drive – Staff willing to help and will invite to a future meeting.
- Cllr Wilson email – re tree roots and pavement – Moss Park Avenue – on 2016/2017 programme but in meantime sections badly affected will be overlaid. (Cllr Watson also emailed regarding this query including streets in Cardonald)
- Cllr Wilson email - Leaves on Boulevard and Moss Park Drive to be part of programme commencing 31 October
- Glasgow Life email – Re Nethercraigs and will continue to monitor car parking and have notice up advising to park in the car park and not at residents' properties over the road. Since yellow lines were introduced on Corkerhill Road this has become more of a problem. (Cllr Torrance also forwarded email)
- Scotrail and Humza Yousaf email – to confirm enquiry has been received and will be investigated into problems with trains being late or cancelled on a regular basis.
- Cllr Watson – email re Cemetery wall – area inspected and fenced off
- Cllr Watson email – Clyde College contacted re parking in neighbouring streets which is causing obstruction and inconvenience to those residents.
- M3C along with HNCP CC helped Morrisons' staff with an elderly resident who needed help with everything. His house was gutted, painted and items were donated. Cllr Wilson contact relevant housing association to assess his needs and it was confirmed he had not been getting the help he was entitled to. He is now very grateful and thanks the whole Community for their generosity.
- Community Gala Day held with Stalled Spaces at Moss Park Square and feedback gained from questionnaire.
- Road Safety Summit Day held by Cllr Watson on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> October was attended by Elaine McSporran and Tommy Lindsay. Fire Brigade, GCC, Police, Community and Parent Councils attended. Concerns raised about ongoing parking at local primary schools. Attendance could have been better than it was.
- Invitation from Cllr Watson to attend meeting regarding the Corkerhill Neighbourhood Hall. This was declined by CC for a number of reasons.
- GCC confirmed that a Parking Pledge System will be issued to all schools after New Year.
