The minutes from last year's AGM on Monday 12th October 2015 were approved as were the minutes from last month's meeting on Monday 19th September 2016.

Chair's Report given by Anne McIntyre

Been a very busy year. Our facebook and website are up and running. Linsey continues to update the website on a regular basis and welcomes any ideas.

Our leaflet drop was successful in gaining a lot more awareness.

Our meetings have become very busy with more residents attending and contributing.

Community Police have been in regular attendance and continue to support the CC. They have been able to help residents with queries.

We have had regular attendance from two of our Elected Members and also our MP and MSP

This means residents have a chance to ask questions on any issues around the area.

Treasurer submitted the accounts which had been audited and our opening balance was £695.27 and our closing balance £830.90

The current office bearers stood down, Anne called for nominations

Chairperson – Elaine McSporrان nominated Diane Andrew and Anne McIntyre seconded it.

Secretary – Diane Andrew nominated Elaine McSporrان and Linsey Wilson seconded it

Vice Chair – We were going to nominate Eddie Gethins as Vice Chair however CC do not allow married couples to hold therefore we have no VC at the moment– (any member can step in if the Chair is absent)

Treasurer – Linsey Wilson nominated Avril Gethins and Elsa Harper seconded it.

We now have two member vacancies and notices will be issued according to guidelines.

The independent examiner of the accounts for next year will be Margaret Wilson

The next AGM will take place on Monday 16th October 2017

The Chair closed the AGM and will now officiate for the normal meeting of the Community Council

- PTU signed to Community Council for Mossspark Square as in order to do anything permission needs to be granted. This is free of charge to the CC for one year.
- A Consultation for Mossspark Square will be held on Monday 24th October 2016 at 6.30pm in Mossspark Primary. This is to present ideas and hear feedback from residents. This is short notice due to unfortunate delays out of the CC hands. Notices will be put up. This can be followed by a small Gala Day to plant some daffodil bulbs and gain information.
- Facebook page now at 450+ members. Website continues to be updated by Linsey.
- Still no response as yet for both DGF funding or Community Choices.
- Awaiting DF Concerts contribution to the community and a meeting still to take place to discuss this.

Community Police

- Thefts, minor vandalism and drinking in the street.
- All investigations are ongoing.

Facebook Page Updates –

Issues with No 34 Service – Not being able to board the bus on Mossspark Boulevard as it is full and having to wait for next bus. Also problems with bus being late. Possibly due to more passengers boarding prior to Mossspark on route to QEH. Cllr Watson was following up on this query.

Cllr Watson arranging a meeting regarding Corkerhill Neighbourhood Hall – no dates as yet or attendees. He will however include an invite to the CC. The CC confirmed they have enquired about this hall and are aware there is no committee in place for it and lease is held by an individual at the moment. There is a desire by the community to be able to utilize this better.

Cllr Alistair Watson

- **No 34:** Made enquiries to SPT regarding the service and complaints made on 21 September. No reply has been given as yet and no confirmation that this service could be improved by adding an extra bus for this time in the morning. There are many changes in public transport and improvements needed around Glasgow. There is a complete unreliability with public transport in general. He will be writing formally to Humza Yousaf MSP who is now the Transport Minister.
- **Corkerhill Neighbourhood Hall:** as noted arrangements for a meeting have been requested and City Property are checking dates in their diary. This will be regarding future of the hall and he is aware accounting not quite up to date.
- **Leaves:** With the budget being cut the level of staff are less therefore leaves are not cleared as they were before.

Cllr Alex Wilson

- **Roads:** Following up complaints regarding tree roots on Boulevard and other streets

- **Summer Sessions:** Still waiting for a date to have meeting DF Concerts to discuss the contribution to the area. Suggested Mossspark Primary get some musical instruments donated or similar as this is central in our community.
- **Mossspark Primary:** Will be attending Mossspark Primary for opening of new library which Parent Council have refurbished.
- **Hardridge Road:** Will follow up on resident enquiry regarding stairs and arrange a site visit from council officer to combat the issue with bins.

Any other Business

- **Leaves:** Why are these not being picked up anymore. They are all over the place and this is slippery and dangerous for residents especially the infirm and elderly. Some are left in bags at side of the road.
- **Roots:** Dangerous and needs attended to asap
- **Bins:** At Hardridge Road these are not being left as should be and this is causing distress for the residents.
- **Motorbike:** As reported previously motorbikes are speeding up Corkerhill Rd late at night. Police urged them to report as soon as heard. This way a lookout can be placed in order to catch those not adhering to speed limits.
- **Bins:** Not enough bins in area and others not emptied enough. Pollokshields seems to have a better system so why does Mossspark not get the same treatment.
- **Mandie Running** – Scottish Government are holding an Education consultation on 10th November 2016. Please go and give feedback on the website.
Scouts did a clear up in Cardonald and although not area requests that on any thread no negative comments are made.

Treasurer's Report

- There are funds of £830.90. Deductions to be made for the let.
- Funds to be credited to the account from Stalled Spaces and then further deductions for Consultation and Gala Day to be taken into account.
